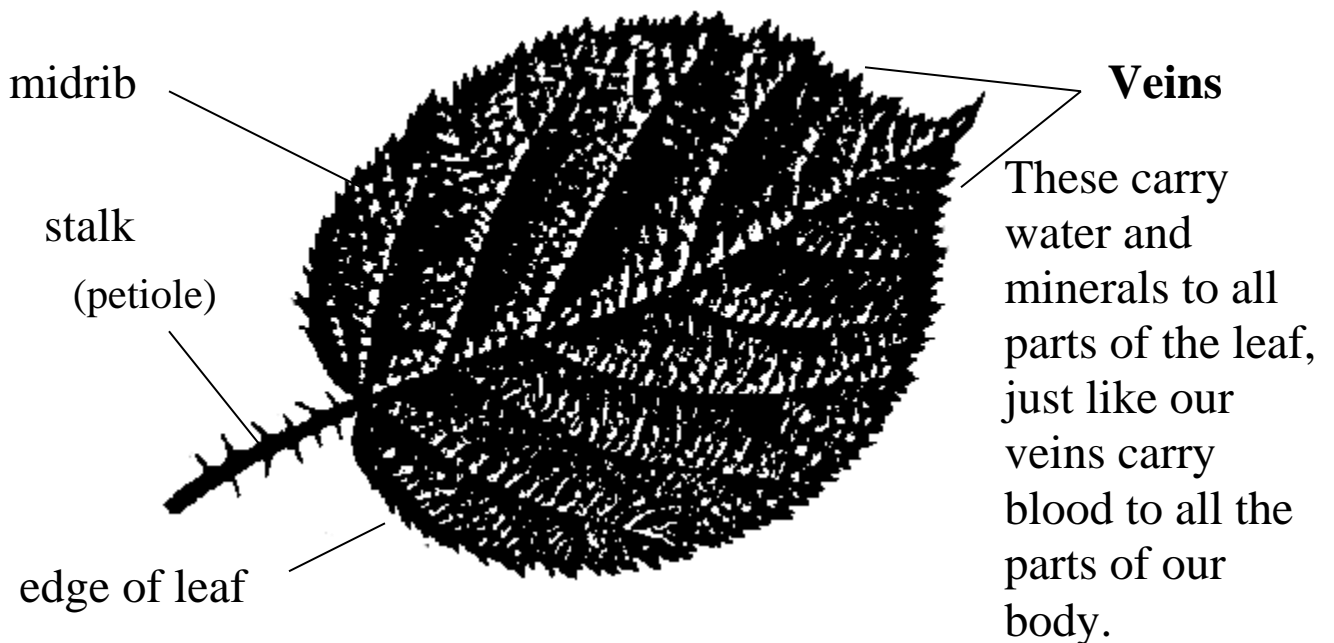


# LEAVES



## Parts of a Leaf

Stick the leaves below and try to name the tree it came from.

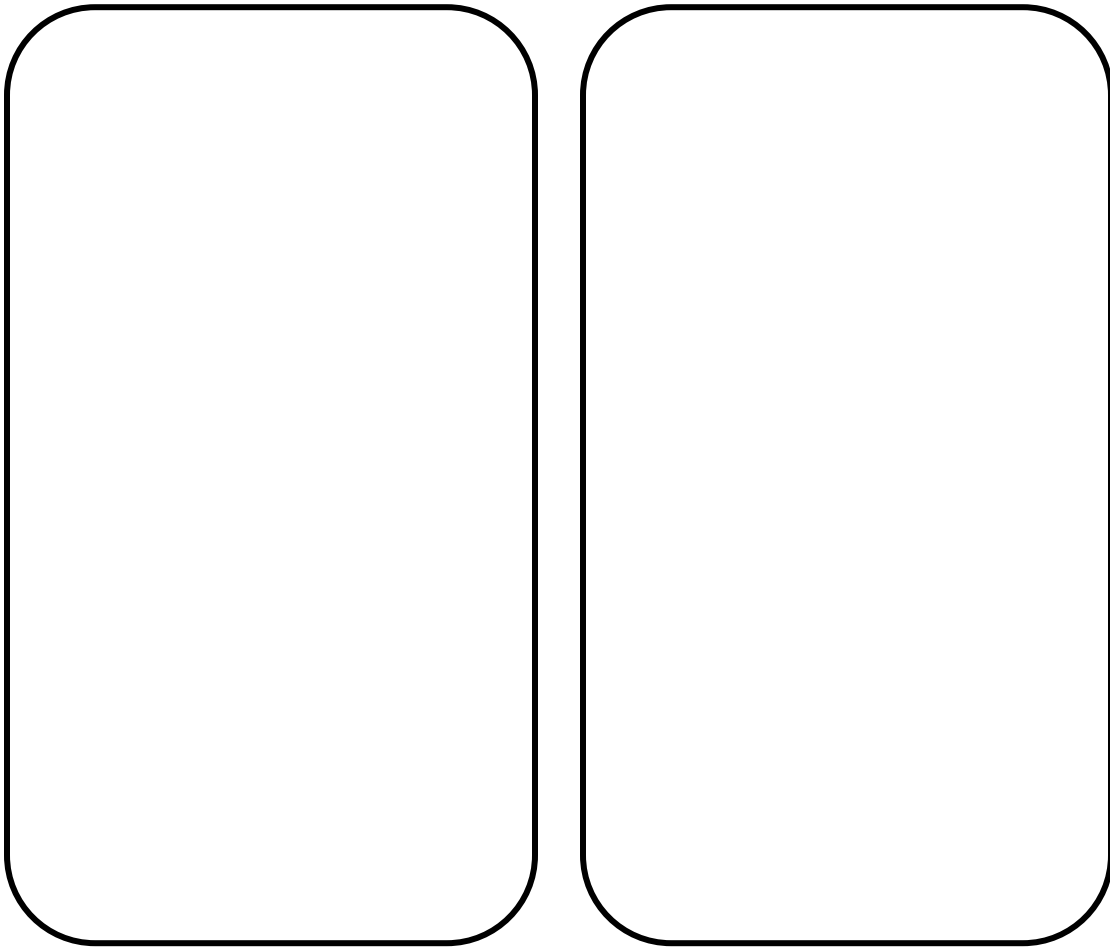
